

2008 Roadrunner Adult Hockey – Summer League

LEAGUE DETAILS – USA HOCKEY REGISTERED LEAGUE

Registration: Until May 23, 2008. Registration will be closed early if all spots fill before the deadline.

Late Registration: Late registrations will be taken if spots are available after the registration period ends, but a 10% late fee will be added. Once the league fills, all registrations received will go on a waiting list.

Number of Games: 15 regular season games plus at least 1 play-off game. (Regular season is projected to run 10 weeks.)

Play-off Format: Top 4 teams seeded, single elimination. Bottom 2 plays consolation game. **(Dependant upon league registration)**

Season Opens: June 9, 2008.

Season Ends: August 2008.

Game Days and Times: Game days and times will rotate. Each team will play at least 1 game per **calendar** week. (We define a calendar week as Monday –Sunday). These estimates are subject to change based on enrollment.

Location: All games will be scheduled at Chaparral Ice – IH 35, unless otherwise noted on the final schedule.

Divisions and Teams: 6 A, 6 B-Tier 1, 6 B-Tier 2, and 6 C. **(dependant upon league registration)**

Player Cost: \$320 **New Player Cost:** \$335

Goalie Cost: \$160 **New Goalie Cost:** \$175

***For EFT payments, see below.

Game Format: 3 13-minute periods with referees and scorekeepers

IMPORTANT DATES AND EVENTS:

Captains' meeting: Undecided if it will be necessary – Contact Jason Maurer if you are interested in being a captain.

New Player's Skate: Chaparral Ice – IH35 A/B1=Wed. 5/28 @ 8:15-9:30 pm. B2/C=Thurs. 5/29 8:30-9:45 pm.

League Draft: Mon 6/2 and/or Tues. 6/3. Specific dates and times dependant upon final enrollment numbers.

Schedule Release: June schedule will be released on draft day. Remainder of schedule will be released by June 16.

How to register online: *Payments are NOT an option when enrolling online.* Go to www.chaparralice.com. On the lower left hand side, there is a section labeled "Quick Links". Click on "Enroll Online Now". A second browser window will open up. If not, then you will need to change your internet security options to allow pop-ups from this site. When you register, fill out as much information as possible so that our records are accurate and we get you registered in the correct division and make note of any special requests you may have – team, multiple divisions, partner requests, position, etc. Contact a cashier @ Chaparral Ice if you have difficulties. As mentioned above, it would be a good idea to also notify the league administrator via e-mail of any special requests.

EFT (Electronic Funds Transfer) payments will be available for the current registration season. Anyone interested in EFT payments must register in person. No on-line or phone enrollment will be accepted for EFT payments. There is an EFT fee of \$25 that is added on to the total registration price. The payment plan for the current registration season is as follows:

Player Cost: \$145 down and two EFT payments of \$100 on approx. July 7 and August 7, 2008 (EFT total=\$345)

New Player Cost: \$160 down and two EFT payments of \$100 on approx. July 7 and August 7, 2008 (EFT total=\$360)

Goalie Cost: \$90 down and two EFT payments of \$50 on approx. July 7 and August 7, 2008 (EFT total=\$190)

New Goalie Cost: \$105 down and two EFT payments of \$50 on approx. July 7 and August 7, 2008 (EFT total=\$205)

If you are a **NEW PLAYER** to the Roadrunner Adult Hockey League, or have not played in the league since at least the Fall/Winter 2007-08 season, make sure you enroll online for the specific division under the "New Player" category. For example, A NEW SKATER, B1 NEW GOALIE, etc. By doing so, you will pay an additional \$15 on your registration fees. This \$15 is to cover your enrollment in the new player evaluation skate. Please be sure your contact info is valid because the league administrator will need to contact you for additional playing history information. **New Player's Skate: See Important Dates and Events above for date and time.**

NOTES: Registration for a specific division does not guarantee that you will be playing in that division. Also, special requests will be noted, but there is no guarantee that we will be able to accommodate them. NO PHONE registration will be allowed. You must enroll on-line or in person at the rink.

Playing in 2 divisions: Players will **not** be allowed to play in 2 divisions **unless** approved to do so by the league administrator. The only exception to this rule will be for player's skating-out in one division and playing goalie in another. If interested in playing in two divisions, contact the league administrator. You will be put on a waiting list until registration is closed and it is determined if there are spots available for you to play in two divisions. However, you must be drafted in the higher division before you can be drafted in the lower division. Players will be contacted **after** the draft if they were selected in two leagues. If selected in two leagues, payment arrangements for the second league will need to be made immediately.

USA HOCKEY REGISTRATION: All players MUST be registered with USA Hockey for the 2007-08 season prior to playing. Proof of USA Hockey will need to be provided upon enrollment. If not enrolled, you can enroll at www.usahockeyregistration.com. Upon completion of enrollment, either e-mail or bring in a copy of the enrollment confirmation e-mail you receive. Players will **NOT** be allowed to play until they have registered for USA Hockey.

Team Composition: Teams will consist of 13 skaters and 1 goalie (pending enrollment). Players will be selected through a draft process. Each league's captains will determine how many players, if any, will be allowed to be pre-drafted (protected).
