

## 2008 Spring/Summer Roadrunner Adult Hockey “Lite”

### **HOCKEY “LITE” DETAILS – USA HOCKEY REGISTRATION REQUIRED**

**Lite Registration:** Until Friday, April 25, 2008 or when it is full - whichever comes first. Space is limited to a maximum of 26 skaters and 4 goalies per group.

**Number of Sessions:** 12

**Sessions Begin:** Sunday, May 4, 2008.

**Sessions End:** Sunday, August 3, 2008.

**Off Days:** May 25 and July 6.

**Game Days and Times:** B/C = Sunday nights @ 6:45 – 8:00 pm. A/B = Sunday nights @ 8:15 – 9:30 pm. Exceptions: 5/4 sessions @ 8:00 and 9:30 pm respectively, and 6/15 sessions @ 8:00 and 9:30 pm respectively.

**Location:** All sessions are at NORTHCROSS MALL.

**Player Cost:** \$125 single payment

**Goalie Cost:** Free. Contact Jason Maurer to get on the schedule for specific sessions. If you miss a scheduled session without finding a replacement, you will be removed from the remainder of the schedule.

**Session Format:** This is an organized, pre-paid drop-in game. No scorekeepers, no refs, no stats. 75-minute time slots.

**How to register online:** Go to [www.chaparralice.com](http://www.chaparralice.com), and go to the Adult Hockey page. Instructions on how to register and what information we will need from you at the time of registration will be on that page as well as a link to the actual online registration form. When you register, fill out as much information as possible so that our records are accurate and we get you registered in the correct division and make note of any special requests you may have – team, multiple divisions, partner requests, position, etc. Contact a cashier @ Chaparral Ice if you have difficulties. As mentioned above, it would be a good idea to also notify the league administrator via e-mail of any special requests.

**EFT (Electronic Funds Transfer) NOT AVAILABLE FOR THE “LITE” SESSIONS.**

**USA HOCKEY REGISTRATION:** All players MUST be registered with USA Hockey for the 2007-08 Ice Hockey season prior to playing. Proof of USA Hockey will need to be provided upon enrollment. If not enrolled, you can enroll at [www.usahockeyregistration.com](http://www.usahockeyregistration.com). Upon completion of enrollment, either e-mail or bring in a copy of the enrollment confirmation e-mail you receive. Enrollment can be done through the rink, but there is an extra processing fee added in to the fee.

**Sharing Spots** is allowed as long as you notify the league administrator that you are sharing with another person. However, if you are sharing, both persons are not allowed to be at any given session at the same time unless given permission. Also, both persons must be registered with USA Hockey.

**NOTES: Registration for a specific division does not guarantee that you will be playing in that division. Also, special requests will be noted, but there is no guarantee that we will be able to accommodate them. NO PHONE registration will be allowed. You must enroll on-line or in person at the IH-35 rink.**
