

## 2012 Roadrunner Adult Hockey – Spring Draft League

### **LEAGUE DETAILS – USA HOCKEY REGISTERED LEAGUE –**

**Registration:** Begins Monday, January 16, 2012 and runs until Monday, February 20, 2012 or until all leagues fill.

**Late Registration:** Late registrations will be taken **IF** spots are available after the registration period ends. Once the league fills, all registrations received will go on a waiting list.

**Number of Games:** 16 regular season games plus at least 1 play-off game.

**Play-off Format:** TBD. Pending final enrollment and league size.

**Season Opens:** March 5, 2012.

**Season Ends:** May 25, 2012.

**Game Days and Times:** Game days and times will rotate. Each team will play at least one game per **calendar** week with an average of 3 games every two weeks. (We define a calendar week as Monday –Sunday). These estimates are subject to change based on enrollment.

**Location:** All games will be scheduled at Chaparral Ice – NORTHCROSS.

**Divisions and Teams:** 4-6 team per division – A, B1, B2, C. (**Projections may change due to final league registration #'s**)

**Game Format:** three 13-minute stop clock periods with referees and scorekeepers. 3<sup>rd</sup> period mercy rule in effect. No Tie games. All games will end with a winner. Tie after regulation will immediately go to 3-round shootout.

#### **\*Participant Cost:**

Player Cost: \$360                      \*\*\*New Player Cost: \$375

Goalie Cost: \$180                      \*\*\*New Goalie Cost: \$195

\*\*\*New Players and New Goalies MUST register as “NEW...” so that they can attend the New Player skate. Also, any existing player that wants to attend the New Player skate to be considered at a higher level must sign up as a new player. No players will be allowed to just show up without registering as a new player.

\*Above prices are for payment in full only. For payment plan, see below EFT section.

**EFT (Electronic Funds Transfer)** payment plans will be available for the Spring season via EFT payments only. To do EFT payments, you must register in person. No on-line or phone enrollment will be allowed for EFT payments. There is an EFT fee of \$25 that is added on to the total registration price. The payment plan for the Spring season is as follows:

#### **A-C Player Cost:**

\$85 down and three additional EFT payments of \$100 on or about the 15th of Mar, Apr, and May (EFT total=\$385)

#### **A-C New Player Cost:**

\$100 down and three additional EFT payments of \$100 on or about the 15th of Mar, Apr, and May (EFT total=\$400)

#### **A-C Goalie Cost:**

\$40 down and three additional EFT payments of \$55 on or about the 15th of Mar, Apr, and May (EFT total=\$205)

#### **A-C New Goalie Cost:**

\$55 down and three additional EFT payments of \$55 on or about the 7th of Mar, Apr, and May (EFT total=\$220)

**Captain's meeting:** TBD (If necessary)

**New Player's Skate:** Chaparral Ice – NORTHCROSS, Sunday, February 26, 2012 @ 8:30 pm for A/B1 and 9:45 pm for B2/C. \*\*\*Dates and times are subject to change\*\*\* All new players will be notified of any such changes.

**League Draft:** Some time between Monday, February 27 and Wednesday, February 29. Only captains are allowed/need to attend. Specific location, date, and time of each leagues draft will be released once locked in.

**Schedule Release:** March schedule will be released within 24 hours of the drafts. Remainder of schedule will be released by Mid-March.

# 2012 Roadrunner Adult Hockey – Spring Draft League

**USA HOCKEY REGISTRATION:** All players MUST be registered with USA Hockey for the 2011-12 season prior to playing. Proof of USA Hockey will need to be provided upon enrollment. If not enrolled, you can enroll at [www.usahockeyregistration.com](http://www.usahockeyregistration.com). Upon completion of enrollment, either e-mail or bring in a copy of the enrollment confirmation e-mail you receive.

**UNIFORMS:** All players are required to wear team uniforms that have the same base color. No mixing white, yellow, grey or black, blue, green, etc together. Per USA Hockey and league rules, this is not acceptable. Every jersey must either be identical, or the base color identical. Also, every jersey must have a permanently affixed (sewn or heat pressed) number. Tape and marker is not acceptable for numbering jerseys. No duplicate jersey #'s are allowed. All subs must also meet these jersey requirements. The only exception is a sub goalie. A sub goalie may wear a jersey that is different from the rest of the team as long as he/she is wearing a light colored jersey if the team's base color is a light color OR a dark colored jersey if the team's base color is a dark color. All rules are in accordance with the USA Hockey rulebook.

## **HOW TO REGISTER:**

**NOTE: Registration for a specific division does not guarantee that you will be playing in that division. Also, special requests will be noted, but there is no guarantee that we will be able to accommodate them.**

**On-line:** *Payment in full is the ONLY option when enrolling on-line.* Go to [www.chaparrallice.com](http://www.chaparrallice.com). On the lower left hand side, there is a section labeled "Quick Links". Click on "Enroll Online Now". A second browser window will open up. If not, then you will need to change your internet security options to allow pop-ups from this site. Scroll over "Program Registration" and select "Adult League" from the drop down menu. Click on "Check Available Time/Sessions". Select appropriate "Season" (Spring 2012). Select Appropriate "Level". Click Continue. Failure to follow these steps can result in you getting registered in the wrong league/division or possibly not enrolled at all. When you register, make sure all personal data is filled out as accurately and completely as possible so that our records are accurate and we get you registered in the correct division. **Northcross Front Desk:** If you plan to go the payment plan route, you must register at the Northcross location during regular business hours. All payments plans MUST be set up according to the payment schedule on the previous page. Please contact the league director for approval if you would like to request special payment arrangements BEFORE registering.

**Other:** NO phone registration will be allowed. E-mail registration allowed if appropriate forms are filled out and e-mailed back completed prior to registration deadline. Contact league director to obtain copies of forms.

If you are a **NEW PLAYER** to the Roadrunner Adult Hockey DRAFT League, or have not played in any of the draft leagues since at least the Spring of 2010, make sure you enroll online for the specific division under the "New Player" category. For example, A NEW SKATER, B1 NEW GOALIE, etc. By doing so, you will pay an additional \$15 on your registration fees. This \$15 is to cover your enrollment in the new player evaluation skate. Please be sure your contact info is valid because the league director may need to contact you for additional playing history information.

**New Player's Skate:** See "Important Dates and Events". Please note that the times are subject to change. We will contact all new players to let them know which skate to attend as well as gather additional player information.

**Playing in 2 divisions:** Players will **not** be allowed to play in 2 divisions **unless** approved to do so by the league director. The only exception to this rule will be for player's skating-out in one division and playing goalie in another. If interested in playing in two divisions, contact the league director before registering. You may be put on a waiting list until registration is closed and it is determined if there are spots available for you to play in two divisions. However, you must be drafted in the higher division before you can be drafted in the lower division.
