



CHAPARRAL ICE CENTER BROOMBALL RULES



Equipment required

- All participants must provide and wear their own helmet for the best comfort and fit.
- Participants must use a regulation broom. No broken sticks may be used at any time.
- Chaparral Ice Center provides broom sticks and balls.
- Participants must wear rubber-soled tennis shoes and provide their own helmets (a bicycle type helmet is fine).

of Players

The optimal number is 10 – 12 players per team on the ice at one time. The absolute maximum is 15 players per team on the ice at one time.

Ice Monitor

- An on-ice monitor will be provided to enforce the rules outlined below.
- The ice monitor has the authority to remove anyone from the ice or the facility who is perceived to be dangerous to themselves or others.

Game Rules

1. No high sticking. (The end of the stick should never be above waist level.)
2. No checking. (slamming another player into the glass or the boards)
3. No tripping.
4. No intentional sliding.
5. No picking up and throwing the ball or kicking the ball.
6. Excessive roughness or aggressiveness will not be tolerated.
7. Players must wear required equipment as outlined above.
8. No alcoholic beverages are allowed in the rink area.
9. Be safe and have fun.

Safety is a priority. Any player behaving in a manner which is perceived to be dangerous to themselves or others will be asked to leave the ice and refunds will not be given.

Liability Waivers

- All participants must sign a liability waiver prior to getting on the ice. If the participant is a minor (under 18 years of age), then they must bring a waiver signed by their parent or guardian in order to participate.

Payment & Cancellations

- You may pay with cash, company check or charge at the time of your event. We do not accept personal checks.
- If you cancel within two weeks of the date of your event, a \$100 cancellation fee will be charged to the credit card number that you gave at the time of your reservation.
- Tax will be added to the hourly fee unless you present a tax-exempt form.

General Info

- You may organize your players and teams however you wish as long as you do not have more than 15 players per team on the ice at one time. Substitutes may sit on the player benches. After player substitutions, the doors must be completely closed before play may resume.
