

Chaparral Ice Figure Skating Team
Terms and Conditions
September 2006 (revised)

Mission Statement:

The Chaparral Ice Figure Skating Team was designed to provide a more in depth education and experience in the sport of figure skating, while promoting a sense of TEAM. This program will help bridge the gap as skaters progress from organized group classes to private individual lessons. Skaters will be introduced to different avenues for participation and enjoyment of the sport of figure skating.

Eligibility:

Open to those skaters who are in Chaparral Ice USFS Learn to Skate program at Basic 6 through Freeskate 6 Levels.

Registration:

Team membership is all-inclusive for a monthly rate of \$115.00 by Electronic Fund Transfers ONLY or the one time payment annual rate is \$1380.00. (Insufficient Funds and or EFT chargeback's will be subject to a \$25.00 per incident service fee)

Benefits to members:

- Unlimited Learn to Skate classes at either/both Chaparral Ice location(s). Classes include but are not limited to Basic Skills Classes and Specialty Classes. Offered ONLY for those within the eligible skill levels.
- Unlimited Bridge Freestyles at either/both Chaparral Ice Location(s) (when available). "Bridge Freestyles" are special 30-minute sessions for Team members only. September through December 2006, all team members will be eligible to attend unlimited afternoon freestyles at the CI Training Center location. This is offered as a temporary replacement for the Bridge Freestyles. Please check freestyle schedules posted on a monthly basis for days and times.
- Approximately 5-6 Educational Workshops will be offered for Team members throughout the year. Schedule TBA.
- USFSA Basic Skills and ISI testing and badges are provided for members at no additional charge.
- Special "member only" pricing, discounts, skating opportunities, test sessions and freestyle punch cards.
- Membership in both USFS Basic Skills (renews every September) and individual membership in ISI (renews annually).
- Unlimited \$3 public skating admissions.

Duration of membership:

- The initial commitment for TEAM members is 1 year. At the conclusion of the initial term, a student is considered a TEAM member for the duration of their enrollment in the eligible skill levels, provided monthly fees are current.
- A 30-day written notice must be provided for termination of membership for any reason other than medically necessary withdrawals.
- A long-term illness or injury resulting in termination of membership must be accompanied with a doctors note
- Cancellation of membership for reasons other than medical must be accompanied by a cancellation fee of \$25.00 per month remaining on the contract (if within the initial contract year).
- As a student "graduates" from the TEAM program, a 30-day notification to the program coordinator is required, and remaining balance, if any, will be applied to a personal account.
- Any and all exceptions (i.e. early graduation prior to fulfilling initial membership term) must be approved by the program coordinator before a membership will be considered terminated.
- Graduation is achieved at the completion of USFS Basic Skills Freeskate 6. All current policies on evaluations and assessments still apply.

Enrollment/Attendance Policy:

- It is not the intent of the program for class attendance to be on a "drop in" basis. Every effort should be made to regularly attend classes for which the student is registered. Chaparral Ice reserves the right to remove a student from a class for inconsistent attendance.
- A student must be enrolled in any class they plan to attend. This provides an accurate enrollment roster for coaches, even though the enrollment will be without fees.
- Chaparral Ice reserves the right to cancel or combine classes depending on enrollment. In the event a class is cancelled due to enrollment, every effort will be made to provide a reasonable substitution.

Enrollment/Attendance Policy (continued):

- **For team members with private coaches, your private coach will be responsible for providing evaluations and assessments.** This is to prevent multiple evaluations, and avoid confusion.
- A team approach will be used to monitor a skater's progress; however it is the student's responsibility to advise the program coordinator of any changes in skill level, class selections, or eligibility concerns.
- Chaparral Ice reserves the right to remove a student from a class or the team for abuse or misuse of the program or disruptive behavior.

Make-up policy:

For any class that is cancelled as a result of weather, or mechanical difficulties beyond our control, there will be NO MAKE-UP provided. For cancellations due to other circumstances, every effort will be made to provide a suitable alternative, but none is guaranteed. Due to the "unlimited" nature of this program, **no make-ups** will be allowed for missed classes.

Refunds:

Due to the nature of this program, refunds will not be issued. In the event of a long-term illness or injury, a hold may be put on the membership for up to 6 months. A 30-day written notice must be provided for termination of membership for any reason other than medically necessary withdrawals. All medical requests must be submitted in writing and include a doctor's statement. This notice must be accompanied by a cancellation fee of \$25.00 per month remaining on the contract (if within the initial contract year).

Liability Waiver:

Ice Skating, Hockey and other ice sports and the use of rental equipment for ice skating and other ice sports involve certain inherent risks, dangers and hazards, which can result in serious personal injury. The skater/participant and/or participant's parent or legal guardian assume and accept all risk of personal injury while in the Chaparral Facility. At all times the skater/participant and/or the skater's/participant or legal guardian shall be fully liable for personal injury and property damage incurred while on the premises. And, the skater/participant and/or the skater's/participants legal guardian agree to hold Chaparral, its officers, agents and employees harmless against any and all liability for claims, demands and causes of action asserted against Chaparral arising from skater's/participants use of the facilities or otherwise, upon the premises.
